

# Student Jobs



## Fast FAQ

- There are two types of student jobs: Federal Work Study (FWS) Jobs and Non-Federal Work Study Jobs – often called wage jobs
- FWS jobs are for students awarded FWS as part of their financial aid package. Wage jobs can be worked by any student attending at least half time (6 Cr. Hrs.)
- Students can work one job or multiple jobs
- Students are allowed to work up to a maximum number of hours based on their employment type  
FWS = 20 Hrs. per week / Not-FWS = 28 Hrs. per week

1. Log into Workday.
2. In the **Applications** section, click the **Career Icon**.
3. In the View Section, click either **Search Students Jobs** or **Search Student Federal Work Study Jobs** if you are searching for Federal Work Study jobs.
  - a. Using the options on the left, narrow down your search by selecting “Wooster Campus” as your location.
4. Click the **Job Title** (ex. Student Assistant) to view the job posting details.
5. Click **Apply** to apply for the job.
