

2022-2023 Financial Aid Checklist

- **Complete the 2022-2023 FAFSA online** at <http://fafsa.ed.gov>.
 - Available **October 1, 2021**
 - **OSU priority deadline February 1, 2022**
 - You will use **2020** income information
 - For **School Selection**, use ***The Ohio State University-all campuses*** federal school code **003090**
 - **Note:** Answer “YES” to the question, “Are you interested in being considered for work-study?”
- **Check your FAFSA status online** at <http://fafsa.ed.gov>
 - Check 3-5 days after you file
- If selected, **complete any required verification items by due date**
 - The university will email you if selected. View your To Do List in Buckeye Link for further details.
- **Complete and submit the *Ohio State ATI/CFAES Scholarship Application***
 - Online application available at <http://ati.osu.edu/scholarship-application> Available **October 2021**.
 - **Priority deadline February 15, 2022**
 - Make sure to select the campus you’ll be attending *Autumn 2022 (ATI/Wooster or Columbus/CFAES)*
 - If awarded, you will be notified via letter in the mail with instructions on accepting your scholarship award.
- **Complete and submit *The Ohio State University Scholarship Universe Application***
 - Online application available year-round at <sfa.osu.edu> for **internal and external scholarship opportunities** (Note: internal options close every Feb. 1)
 - **Priority deadline February 1, 2022**
 - **Note:** Log in with your OSU username and password.
 - **If awarded**, you will be notified via the ‘Aid Summary’ tab on Buckeye Link.
- **OSU Alumni Scholars Program –** scholarship opportunities available on ScholarshipUniverse application
 - **Timeline: December 1, 2021 – February 15, 2022**
- **Review your OSU financial aid award** by logging into *Buckeye Link* at <https://buckeyelink.osu.edu/>.
 - **Note:** The university will communicate via OSU webmail when your award is available. If registered for Summer 2022, you will be awarded in April. If registered for Autumn 2022, you will be awarded in May.
- **Investigate private sources** of financial aid for college for external scholarships. Check with your local community/county foundations, local library, local businesses and civic organizations, and your parent(s) employers.
- **FASTChoice (private loan options):** Private loans take an average of 3-4 weeks to process.
